The GGN will support the activities of the National Geoparks Networks, which will communicate the Geopark values and message to the local communities, as well as to national authorities and institutions using national and local languages.	<ul> <li>Create a Guide on best practices to support the National Geoparks Networks to rise Geoparks brand visibility to the broader public at the national level. This includes the organization of various activities (i.e. National Geoparks Conference, participation in tourist fairs with a stand, organization of a Geopark Day, open to the public national events, Exhibitions, Publications, and Volunteers Programs).</li> <li>Update the framework of the National Geoparks Networks according to the national Geoparks</li> </ul>
Promote the Global Geoparks Network at the national level as the mechanism to achieve global visibility for the UNESCO Global Geoparks and their activities and products.	<ul> <li>Facilitate the communication and collaboration with National and Regional Authorities to support Geoparks operation and activities</li> <li>Support the organization of National Geopark Conferences;</li> <li>Support the participation in National Tourism Fairs</li> <li>Promote the Geoparks in events open to the public and organization of activities to raise the visibility of the Geopark concept and their results;</li> <li>Promote initiatives to exchange good organizational practices between Geoparks and National bodies.</li> </ul>

#### STRATEGIC ACTION 5 GGN Members

#### 5.1. GGN Institutional members

Strategic Goals	Action
Encourage all institutional members to work consistently throughout each four years period to constantly improve their quality and service;	Develop a space in the GGN to share the relevant elements of this description that allows the Geoparks the discovery of good practices, models and cooperation initiatives. Obtain external information from the roster of evaluators in order to detect common elements that should be proposed for the improvement of Geoparks.
Provide a <b>good practice guide for Geopark</b> <b>partners</b> and a frame for the use of the GGN logo by Geopark partners;	Good practice guide for Geopark partners: for example, explaining how a partner can take advantage of the international cooperation catalysed by the GGN. Geopark partners that have participated in international activities through the GGN could be authorised to use the GGN logo in their promotion.
Encourage all institutional members to participate in GGN working groups (and Regional Networks Working groups) and contribute to the initiatives developed by working groups more actively;	GGN should propose a greater relationship between regional and global working groups, highlighting common elements and looking at pathways for global progress. Based on the results of this observation, it could propose specific meetings between similar working groups of regional networks or focused workshops on international conferences. The working groups of the GGN could be configured as analysts of the progress, concerns and initiatives of the regional groups. In some cases, it could detect topics of interest that must be addressed globally, seeking effective global results.

Publicize the GGN philosophy, <b>emphasize</b> <b>active participation and involvement</b> of local residents and stakeholders, especially in the territories where local residents are poorly informed about the knowledge of UNESCO Global Geoparks or even neglected by local governments;	Geopark bottom-up approach requires the participation of the local stakeholders. Being one of the peculiarities of UNESCO Global Geoparks, the GGN should make available tools and participation models considered successful at the local level and that can be globally disseminated. Special collection procedures and workshops could be programmed for this purpose.
Encourage the GGN institutional members to continue to produce new outstanding and good practices, which can be shared by other Geoparks and can result in positive influences, benefitting all and contributing to the creation of <b>a more</b> <b>cooperative and peaceful future</b> for all.	UNESCO Global Geoparks should be understood as a Program for Peace: A program that affirms a great respect for the communities, for their heritage and their culture but that offers undeniable opportunities for mutual collaboration and recognition. Opening more paths in the GGN in this sense will always be positive.
<ul> <li>GGN Executive Board has to:</li> <li>Encourage all institutional members to participate in conferences in other continental networks;</li> <li>Encourage all institutional members to develop partnerships and exchange projects with partners on Sustainable Development Goals of Agenda 2030 of UN.</li> </ul>	Distribute information, select cooperation themes, catalyse preparatory meetings, support common expected results and propose dissemination tools for final reports and products.
