Management and Financial Status

- The management body is an Association formed by 19 municipalities and 2 county councils.
- We obtain funding throughout Association memberships, the Catalan Government, the Lleida regional Government and from European local development projects.

Geoconservation

- Palaeontological inventory of 34 selected sites.
- Ore mineral deposits inventory of 22 sites.
- Fauna inventory related to micro mammals in the Area of Montsec, together with students of some high schools.
- Inventory of local varieties of vegetables in the Northern area of the Geoparc. This contributes to an inventory of the whole Geopark that has now 40 varieties.
- Tutoring and accommodation for three students carrying out their final project of Geological degree and support for the master's degree in mineral resources and geological risks.
