1. GEOPARK IDENTITY

2. GEOPARK FIGURES

Number of Geopark staffs: 7 staffs including 1 geoscientist

Number of visitors: The visitors to the most outstanding geosite of the UGGp "Montañas del Fuego" were 921.345 and as for the Visitors Center, was around 27.978 since january 2024 until april 2.024. Before, in 2023 it was free entry.

Number of Geopark events: The events held by management body were approximately 9 and the events cooperative organization were approximately 10.

Number of school classes realize Geopark educational programmes: Activities were carried out for 2.600 students in the new informative educational program called "La GeoComunidad", that has been implemented in educational centers from infant and primary education and in secondary and high school centers (from 3 to 17 years old), a different activity for each year.

Number of Geopark press release: In addition to the information published on the UGGp Social Media (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter and Tik Tok) and the website (www.geoparquelanzarote.org), press releases have been published about the activities of the UGGp.

3. GEOPARK ACTIVITIES

Major achievements in 2023

 The biggest challenge for the geopark was to complete the museography project for the new volcano house and geopark. From the geopark staff, all the scientific coordination of the museum contents was carried out and also from the tourism management part, everything related to furniture, technology, etc. The museum opened on March 18, 2023, with the presence of more than 300 prominent people from the world of science, politics, important institutions, etc.

Management and Financial Status

- The financial status of the UGGp has been the same as in 2022, with the same budget. Regarding management, several environmental agents have been hired, who collaborate with the environmental service in monitoring places of geological interest.
- Subsidy granted by the Government of the Canary Islands to the Geopark.
- The geopark headquarters has moved to an emblematic place on the island, located in one
 of the geopark's geosites. It is also a symbolic place of cultural heritage, Monumento al
 Campesino.

New education programmes on geoconservation, sustainable development and disaster risk reduction

- Course on geopark conservation, aimed at environmental auditors who verify that filming in the landscape meets conservation criteria.
- Collaboration with regulated education, tutoring of "Education and Environmental Control Technician" students
- Various talks to Geopark institutes and foreign exchanges.
- Course on Geopark for teachers of formal education. 40 attendees.
- Activities "The Geopark in colors", the students make a video related to one of the colors of the Geopark, for example, white, recorded by the Geosite Las Salinas.

Strategic partnership

- The UGGp has extended its agreement with the European Space Agency for three more years. Support in the organization with the ESA of Pangaea 2023.
