3. GEOPARK ACTIVITIES

Major achievements in 2023

Start and kick-off event for the UNESCO5 project at the Old Brickworks. Four UNESCO sites from three programmes and Domowina, the organisation responsible for the intangible cultural heritage of Lusatia's Slavic minority, the Sorbs, are working together on the project. The first major permanent exhibition for the Geopark was opened at the Old Brickworks, the headquarter of EGTC ltd. in Klein Kölzig. Plans were drawn up for the tourist upgrading of the area around the Old Brickworks and 100% funding was obtained. The revalidation mission has taken place.

Management and Financial Status

The financing was secured by annual membership fees, which provide the basic financial resources. The EGTC also receives annual grants from the federal states of Saxony and Brandenburg. The annual budget in 2023 was 476.900 EUR + 2 small funding projects with 10 TEUR each.

Geoconservation

• signing of cooperation agreements with the geological services of Poland and the federal states in Brandenburg and Saxony and first meeting including site inspection

Sustainable tourism (Geotourism)

• installation of geopark regulations (panels) at frequently visited geopark locations

New education programmes on geoconservation, sustainable development and disaster risk reduction

- organisation of a school competition for Earth Day involving 19 schools and 500 students from Poland and Germany
- development of an all-day educational program on the topic of sand

Strategic partnership

The EGTC ltd began negotiations with potential future new members, two regional authorities in the Free State of Saxony, in order to further expand and broaden the support structure. Cooperation agreements were concluded with the geological services of Saxony, Brandenburg and Poland.
