3. GEOPARK ACTIVITIES

Major achievements in 2023

January / December Project 'Gateways of the Park' - All the gateways of the Park were opened offering museum services, educational workshops, cultural events, exhibitions and guided excursions.

18 January - Closing event of the Technoqualisalus project closely linked to GEOFood and the presentation of a basket of high quality, high health value food products. On this occasion, 20 videos of all the farms that participated in the project were presented.

22 April Earth Day - The Geopark was awarded the 'Parco Inclusivo' National Prize for its activities on accessible tourism promoted by the UniVerde Foundation and the Italian Geographic Society and FIABA onlus.

25 September XIX Giornata del Contemporaneo, Gateway to the Park in Gerfalco The theme is 'Ecology, Sustainability and Awareness' and the project 'Naked Plants. Reversing the human vision to understand the system we live in', by photographer and architect Gianluca Balocco.

November The Marine World Aquarium in Valpiana (Massa Marittima) was welcomed among the Gateways to the Park

3 December - Creation of the Urban Route with panels and podcasts of the Mining Village of Niccioleta (Massa Marittima). During the 1930s, this village was built next to the mine; a typical example of Rationalism, a style widespread in the fascist era with the characteristics of a workers' settlement of the time, where the houses of the miners, workers and management were located close to the production facilities and divided into zones according to social class.
