PREFACE

#### Global Change - what does it mean for mankind?

One thing is for sure – nothing stays the same. Thus the UNESCO Global Geoparks provide ideal model territories for implementing the Agenda 2030. They form the decisive interface between international declarations of intent and concrete on-the-spot activities – which means the transformation from strategy to action.


