PREFACE

Global Change – what does it mean for mankind?

One thing is for sure – nothing stays the same. Our environment, our whole planet and its giant systems, the climate, oceans, sea level and atmosphere are changing, with foreseeable massive consequences for the lives of all humans on Earth. In the light of these changes, which will have a massive effect on our life and that of our heirs, it is high time to stand up for the preservation of our natural basis, which is the survival base for our own existence.

The response of the world community - the Agenda 2030

In September 2015, after decades of negotiations, the United Nations have agreed with the Agenda 2030 on 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). This agenda with 169 subgoals is aimed at ending poverty, hunger and inequality, protect the planet and opening the way for environmentally-friendly progress (the five "P" Planet, People, Prosperity, Peace, Partnership). The 193 member states of the United Nations have committed themselves to implement these goals by 2030, which now need to be implemented from the international level down to the smallest community.

How the UNESCO Global Geoparks can support the Agenda 2030 – from strategy to action:

For 20 years now and all over the world, UNESCO Global Geoparks have campaigned for a holistic understanding of our planet and its evolution. With their initiatives, environmental education and awareness programmes and projects, they place a special emphasis on conveying these natural interrelationships and the impact Man has on these. Their international network is an opportunity for exchanging ideas with partners around the world.

In accordance with their potentials, UNESCO Global Geoparks have been actively pursuing the Global Agenda 2030 with the 17 SDGs for a number of years. Their bottom-up approach with community participation and capacity building, their sustainable regional development

activities as well as their networking from regional to international level make the UNESCO Global Geoparks ideal places to understand the relevance of the SDGs and also the responsibility of their implementation.

Thus the UNESCO Global Geoparks provide ideal model territories for implementing the Agenda 2030. They form the decisive interface between international declarations of intent and concrete on-the-spot activities – which means the **transformation from strategy to action**.

Pillars & tasks of the GGN SDG Working Group

- Strengthening the implementation of the Agenda 2030 with the 17 SDGs in its overall context and communicating the active and supporting role of the UNESCO Global Geoparks, their philosophy, operation and daily tasks in this context
- Coordination, collection and sharing of information and best practice examples from Working Groups of regional UNESCO Global Geopark networks
- Consideration and comparison of different SDG priorities within UNESCO Global Geoparks.
- > To be implemented
 - Coordination of regular capacity building for GGN members by SDG information and vocational training on
 - how to connect the SDGs with the Geopark's work including best practice and examples;
 - o how to explain to the local communities the importance of the SDGs;
 - o how to develop new applications and materials on SDGs;
 - how to integrate the Agenda 2030 to the Geoparks' strategies and management plans.
- Suggestion of the integration of SDGs into existing training formats (Intensive Course on Geoparks Lesvos and China, UNESCO Summer University on Geoparks Portugal...)
- Suggestion of obligatory Keynote Speech and Conference Session on Agenda 2030 SDGs / climate change at all Conferences of the UNESCO Global Geoparks
- > Promotion regular SDG workshops of the GGN and in Regional Networks



Support of communication and visibility of the Agenda 2030 / SDGs in UNESCO Global Geoparks via SDG template to be completed regularly as part of the Global Geoparks Annual Reports

Actions:

Development and establishment of a "SDG Code of behavior" for meetings and conferences of the GGN and regional networks

Global Geoparks Conference hosts:

- > avoid plastic and single-used materials whenever possible
- save paper and water
- serve regional and seasonal food, consider vegetarian and vegan options

Conference participants:

- If possible use clean energy transportation for travelling
- if not possible: CO₂ consumption of flights inside the UNESCO Global Geoparks (e.g. tree planting) or by external measures (e.g. atmosfair)

Awareness, communication tools & visibility

Formation of an Agenda 2030 sub-platform at the GGN website with basic information on SDGs and options for subtopics, best practice and actions including event calendar

An improvement on IT for the GGN Web-Site is necessary!!! – to be integrated in the budget for 2024!

- Collection of best practice SDGs examples from different Geoparks for SDG platform at the GGN website
- Integration of the annual UN Days into the GGN calendar: e.g. Day of Mother Earth (22th April), Day of Biodiversity (22th May), Day of Biodiversity (6th October) Day of Disaster Risk Reduction (13th October), Day of Soil (5th December)
- Publication of 2nd volume of "Geoparks going green "SDGs & UNESCO Global Geoparks – from theory to action" dedicated to the 20th GGN anniversary (best practice from all continents)
- Preparation of GGN SDG activity report for UNESCO Secretariat by new template information given by GGN members



- Further development of existing SDG PR tools including booth, postcard and update of UNESCO brochure, SDG booth, SDG exhibition
- Publication of a collection of existing UGGp conference abstracts regarding SDGs and climate change from the last 7 years as scientific reference (UNESCO website, GGN website)

From quality implementation to quantitative measures

- > Collection of best practice examples worldwide
- Identification of criteria to link up GGN acitivites with SDGs, success measures and quantitative data (e.g. number of activities, participants, budgets...)
